HOW TO NOMINATE A VETERAN

Submissions can be emailed to vets@nationalable.org with the following information due **by October 1**.

INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- Name of awardee
- Years of service
- Branch/component of service
- Email
- Phone number
- Photographs (2 to 5 photos of the veteran both in military uniform and in civilian attire after military service)
- 500 words or less about how they served their community after or during their military service and why they deserve to be recognized
- Name and contact information of person submitting if different than awardee
