WHAT:

National Able Network, Inc., is a nonprofit agency working to serve families and communities by bringing together businesses and qualified job seekers of all ages, income and skill level.

HOW:

At National Able Network, our mission is to help make careers happen. Each client receives personalized career supports that integrate career coaching, specialized training, and direct connections to the job market. Our programs are designed to assist jobseekers from all backgrounds, including the unemployed, career changers, military veterans, seniors, and aspiring IT professionals. Each year, National Able Network serves more than 76,000 individuals throughout Delaware, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa and Nebraska.

The agency directs its \$18 million in annual funding into client programs and services, which include:

- Best-Practice <u>Job Readiness Training</u> (3 languages)
- Specialized programs which help <u>military veterans</u> transfer their skills into the civilian workforce
- <u>Senior Services</u> division provides specialized assistance to job seekers over the age of 50
- Comprehensive <u>one-stop centers</u> and programs such as the <u>Workforce</u> <u>Innovation and Opportunity Act</u> (WIOA) and <u>Trade Adjustment Assistance</u>
- Regional workforce strategies, including serving as the Board Executive for 10 counties throughout <u>Southeast Indiana</u>
- Technology-based <u>Resource Centers</u> for use in creating resumes, cover letters, or to conduct a job search in all offices
- Services to businesses including full assessment and analysis of current and future workforce needs, customized training options, and access to qualified job applicant pool
- Career transition and outplacement services
- Transitional and subsidized employment programs
- Sector-based training programs <u>IT Career Lab</u> and <u>Retail Career Lab</u>
- <u>CareerPlace and Executive Network Group</u>, located in Barrington, Ill., assists their clients by providing job search skills training, coaching, and compassionate support in a safe, positive, high-energy environment
